About Visit:

Firstly, we take permission to Rahul enterprises, pharmaceutical distributor, Wholesale and retail, Nashik Maharashtra for a field visit for academic curriculum.

KVN IOPER, Nashik organized a Wholesale pharmacy visit to a Rahul enterprises, Pharmaceutical distributor, Wholesale and retail, Nashik Maharashtra on 28th August 2024, for 2nd year D. pharmacy students.

2nd year D. pharmacy students with faculty member Mr. Yogesh S. Thakare, Ms. Dipali Ghuge, Ms. Madhuri Nikam, Mr. Ganesh Sangale, Ms. Saniya Patel were present for Pharmaceutical distributor, Wholesale pharmacy visit on 28th August 2024.

Detail of the Visit:

- 1. We started Journey from KVN naik Pharmacy college with all students. We left for visit at 12:00 pm.
- 2. We reached Rahul Enterprises at 12:30 pm.
- 3. The wholesale pharmacy visit started with a warm welcome at 12:45 o'clock followed by the introduction of the owner of Rahul enterprises, Pharmaceutical distributor, Mr. Nitin Shinde.
- 4. Mr. Nitin Shinde introduced himself and the working of the Pharmaceutical Distributor.
- 5. The ethical practices of operating a Pharmaceutical distributor were also thoroughly covered by him.
- 6. He gave information on detailing the pharmacies operations, managing expiry medicines, software used for billing etc. and being familiar with each drug category and protocols.
- 7. Then the setup of the pharmacy layout was discussed by Mr. Nitin Shinde.
- 8. Followed by the visit, students participated in a question-answer session where Mr. Nitin Shinde responded to a variety of topics.
- 9. The college faculty member presented Mr. Nitin Shinde with a gesture of appreciation.
- 10. Then the return journey started at 2 pm o'clock, all students reached the college, and from there all dispersed to their respective places.
- 11. Confirmation of reaching safety was taken.

Summary

The Opportunity to a Pharmaceutical distributor and realities of the Pharmacy profession was a great experience. Additionally, it was helpful for knowledge management in terms of persons ability to manage their social and civic responsibilities as a pharmacist. Mr. Nitin Shinde offered a description of Medicine distributors in terms of ethical, Narcotic, and OTC medication.

The procedure necessary for replacing broken or expired drugs were also followed. Along with the significance of advertisement-based marketing, he also spokes about the management of employees in the pharmacy industry. He also addressed steps in the packaging any medicine order sent out to the cities chemists. There was also a brief discussion of the codes of conduct of business. He provided a brief overview of the chain that went from co-operation to the distributor, and how it arrived at the retail pharmacy where it was then going to patient by the pharmacist. 
