About Visit:

Detail of the Journey:

6. She gave information on detailing of procedure of adoption of child, various programs conducted.
7. Then the setup of the orphanage building, childs living room was discussed by Miss. Manjushree mam.

8. Followed by the visit, students participated in a question-answer session where Miss. Manjushree was discussed to a variety of topics.
9. The college faculty member presented Miss. Manjushree mam with a gesture of appreciation.
10. Then the return journey started at 4 pm o'clock, all students reached the college, and from there all dispersed to their respective places.
11. Confirmation of reaching safety was taken.

Summary:

The Opportunity to visit Orphanage and realities of the orphan child was a great experience.

The procedure necessary for adoption of child was discussed by Miss. Manjushree madam. Along with the significance of caring of child was discussed, like Residential care; The facility of toilet, bathroom and all other essential things is available;

Food and Nutrients Supplements; Nutrients are given to the children in breakfast for strong immunity system.

Medical Facility; provided medical facility to the children's in which their routine check-up is done and medicine or treatment is given if required.

Education: The children's living at the shelter home is enrolled in school so that they can be educated and live their life with dignity in their future.

Entertainment: television and indoor and outdoor games facility is available at the shelter home.

Events: annual programme, birthday celebration and festival celebrations are arranged.

Bedding Facility: A good quality mattress is provided to the beneficiary for rest and to have his sleep.

She also spoke about the management of employees in the orphanage. She also addressed steps in various activities like Tree plantation, Andhrashdhaa nirmoolan, Save girl child etc. There was also a brief discussion of the codes of conduct of business. Students were well mannered and disciplined throughout the visit. This visit was arranged for First year D.pharmacy. The guiding faculty on site were very supportive for all students. We all benefit and bring positive change in our thinking and practical behaviour regarding education.
