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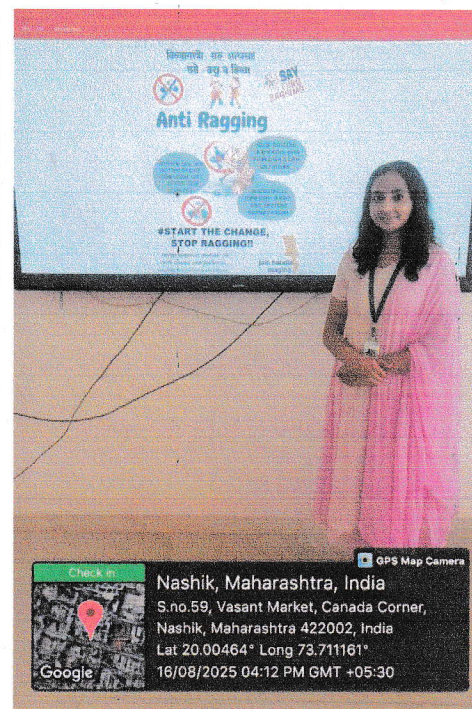
A REPORT ON ANTI-RAGGING DAY AND ANTI-RAGGING WEEK 2025

Brief Report
on Activity

In compliance with the University Grants Commission (UGC) directives, Krantiveer Vasant Rao Narayanrao Naik Shikshan Prasarak Sanstha's Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research has taken proactive steps to create awareness and instill a culture of respect, discipline, and inclusivity among students. To further strengthen this initiative, Anti-Ragging Day was observed on 12th August 2025, followed by Anti-Ragging Week celebrated from 12th to 18th August 2025.

The week-long program included **multiple awareness activities, competitions, and campaigns** to sensitize students towards the consequences of ragging and the importance of creating a safe and healthy learning environment.

On 12th August 2025 The celebration commenced with an **official inauguration** by the Principal, faculty members, and all students. **Dr.A.B.Darekar** addressed students regarding awareness and consequences of ragging, highlighting the role of students as ambassadors of a safe and respectful campus culture. **He noteworthy stated that since the establishment of a college, not a single incident of ragging has ever been observed or reported.**

A **Pledge ceremony** was organized where all students and staff solemnly took the Anti-Ragging Oath, promising to uphold values of respect, dignity, and mutual care.

Day-wise activities were scheduled and conducted throughout a week.

On 13th August 2025 following two competitions were conducted-

1) Essay Writing Competition-

An essay writing competition was conducted with topics such as:

1. Ragging – A Social Evil
2. Ragging and Its Impact on Student's Mental Health

The coordinators for a competition are Prof.A. H. Ahire and Prof. A. V. Bhavar. The students expressed their thoughts on the significant topics given by coordinator. Competition held in Seminar hall at 3.30pm. Total 08 students from different classes were participated in the competition. The Essay entries were judged by Prof. A. J. Jadhav, Prof. T. V.
